RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Contestants are required to play three tunes of their choice in the following order: a waltz, a jig or clog and a reel.
2. Each contestant is allowed four minutes to complete these three tunes.
3. Each contestant shall have only **one** accompanist. The accompanist may chord the tune or play melody.
4. A tuned piano is provided.
5. An accompanist is provided for those contestants who do not wish to provide their own.
6. In the event of circumstances beyond the contestant's control, for example, a broken string, the contestant is allowed to replay.
7. Judging is based on time, tone, technique and overall accuracy.
8. The decisions of the judges are final.
9. Each contestant is eligible to enter **one** class.
10. There is no entry fee.
11. Contestants **must pay** admission to the Fair.
