## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors are to read the "Produce" Rules and Regulations and the "General" Rules and Regulations (See Index – Page 1).
2. Each exhibitor will receive an "Admit One" pass with their entry. Admission passes **will not** be valid on Saturday evening. Ticket to be handed in at the gate upon admission to the grounds. No charge for entry on Friday evening or Saturday morning. A card with your exhibitor number will be issued.
3. All exhibits are to be tagged and properly packaged for exhibit.
4. Exhibits to be delivered to the west door of the Junior Fair Building on Friday of Labour Day weekend between 4:00 and 7:00 p.m. or on Saturday between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m.
5. Exhibits of Grains and Seeds must contain 2 – 5 lbs. of 2007 or 2008 crops in a large size plastic bag with zip closure.
6. Hay to be presented in a clear plastic bag or grain bag only. NO BOXES.
